SPONSORSHIP APPLICATIONS AND CONDITIONS

- Sponsorships will be confirmed following receipt of a signed Sponsorship Form, at which point a binding contract is formed between the Sponsor and the Organiser and the Organiser will issue a tax invoice to the Sponsor.
- Rights of a Sponsor shall not be assignable to any other company or person.
- The Organisers reserve the right at their discretion to decline any application.

CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT

- The total sponsorship amount will be invoiced upon confirmation of your sponsorship. Non-payment of invoice by the due date may result in your sponsorship being cancelled.
- All payments must be made in Australian Dollars.

GENERAL

- "Event" refers to the AHANA official launch breakfast event on 9 August 2023 at the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre.
- "Organiser" refers to Allied Health Assistants' National Association Ltd and includes parties engaged by them as their representative.
- "Sponsor" includes any person or company and its employees or agenda identified in the Sponsorship Form.
- "Sponsorship" means the agreement by the Sponsor to provide financial support to the Organiser, as stated in the Sponsorship application, if accepted by the Organiser and subject to any variation agreed between the Sponsor and the Organiser in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

- The Organiser and the Sponsor are subject to any site and/or event requirements and rules from the event site (Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre).

- If the Event is interrupted or cancelled, the Organiser may refund a portion of the paid amount, determined to be fair by the Organiser having regard to the expenses incurred by the Organiser prior to the interruption or cancellation. If the Organiser decides to change the location or dates of the Event for any reason, no refund will be given. Instead, the Organiser will assign the Sponsor other suitable opportunities, and the Sponsor agrees to comply with the same terms for those opportunities. The Organiser is not financially liable or obligated if the Event is cancelled, postponed, or relocated, except as stated in these Terms and Conditions.
- In the event of unforeseen circumstances such as strikes, lock-outs, closures, or riots, the Organiser may change the dates, opening/closing times, or even cancel the Event.
- Any amendments to these Terms and Conditions must be made in writing and agreed by both Sponsor and Organiser.
